Excuse me, why are you chasing him?

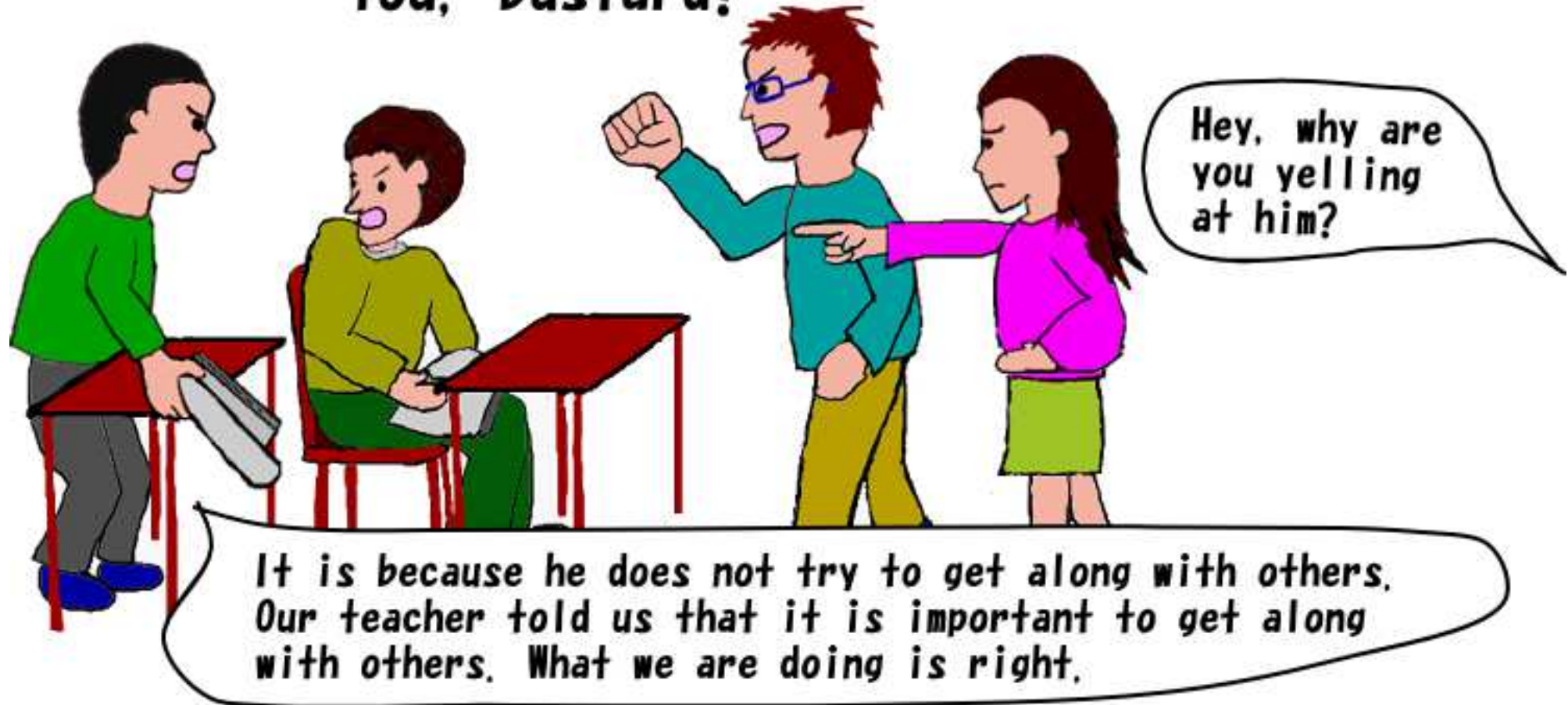
This is to arrest a bad man. We policemen are the allies of justice!

A believer of a certain religion is setting a poisonous gas in a train.



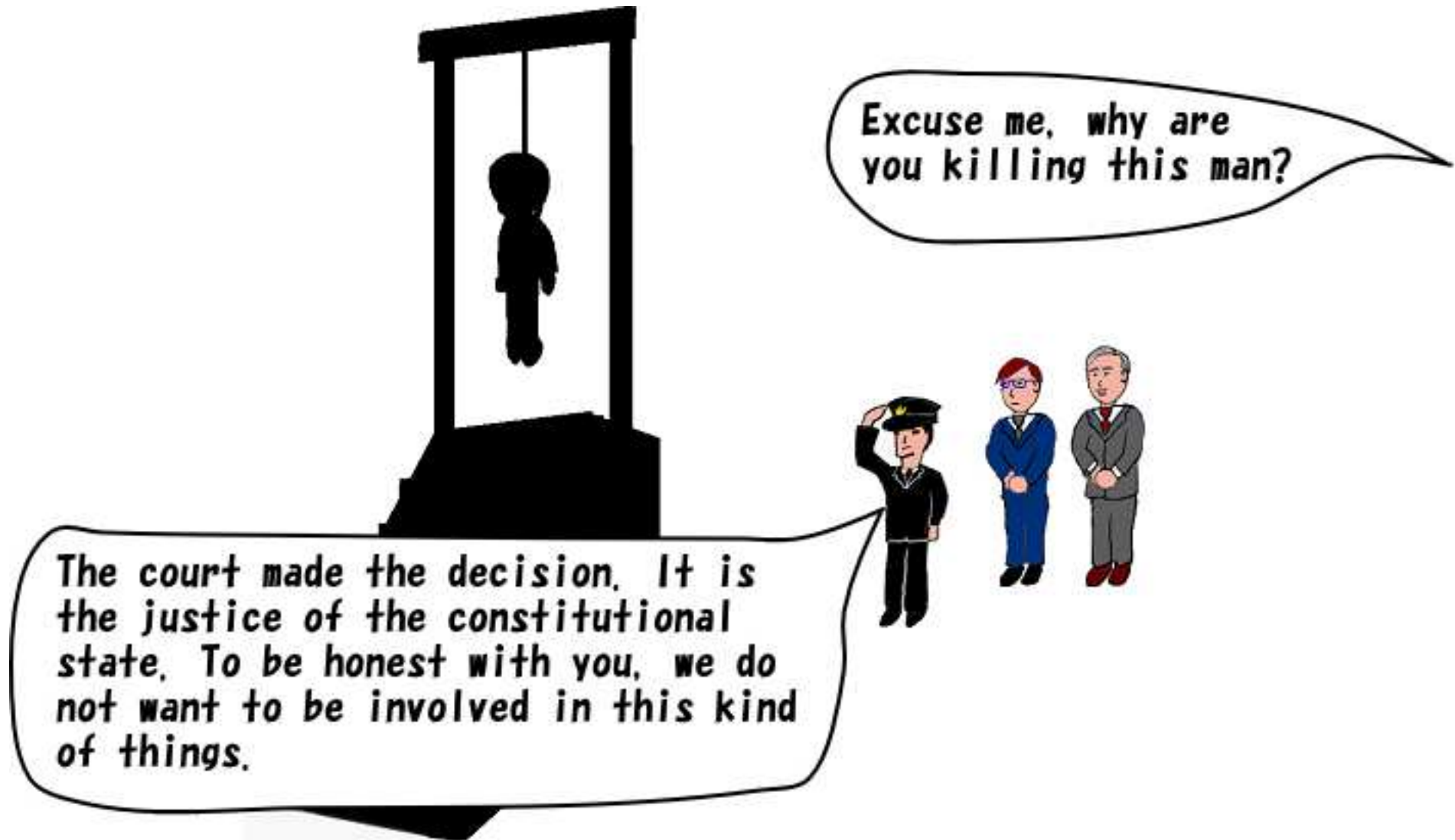
My spiritual leader said, 'If you leave them alive, they will accumulate more sins.' What I am doing is the right thing to do.

An airplane is dropping bombs and killing people.



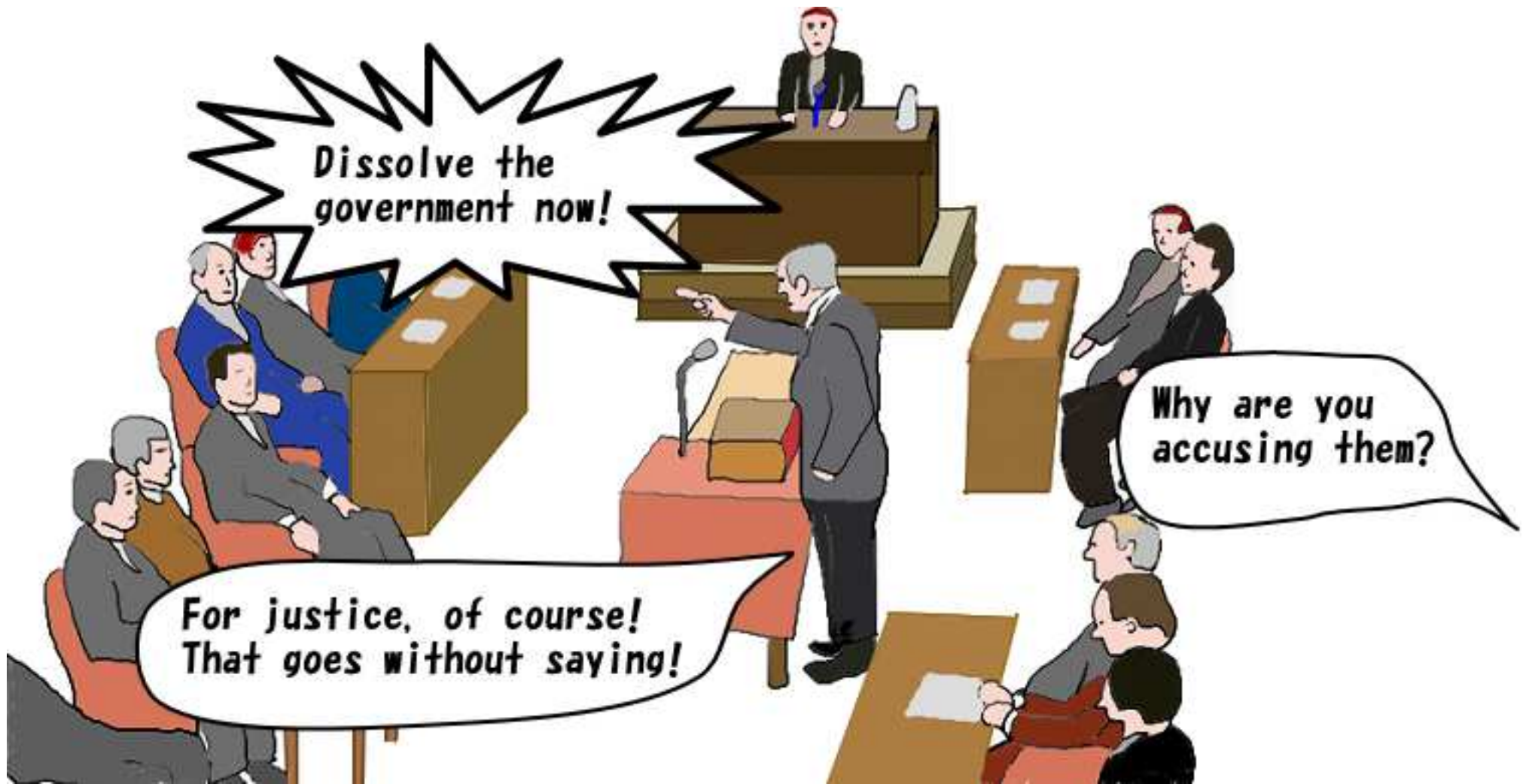
Someone is executed.
