


God, Good and Evil

fishes with bacteria.




The prophet conveyed God's message to the people.

The prophet conveyed the message to the people.




Therefore, the people stated to eat a lot of fish.

Soon after, most of the fish have been eaten, only a few of them remained.




After all, many people have starved to death.

God felt very sad, because it loved the people deeply.




People writhe in darkness without receiving precious love of God because of the illusion of *right and wrong*.
