
It's Three Dimensions





There are some idiots existing in our world. For example, suppose there is a rectangle.




If someone said like this, you would surely feel irritated, wouldn't you?

Or suppose there are two rectangles,




If this kind of things happens, the humans will never have mutual understandings.

Look, everyone is claiming that he/she is right.




After all, which one is right?

Which one is right;


Is that the only way of thinking you have?

Things look different according to each viewer's position.




The more positions from which you see a thing, the more sterically, in other words, the more accurately you may perceive it.
